Day 1 - Your holiday begins today

Today you will need to check in at the airport to begin your tour to Thailand.

Check in at the Mumbai International Airport for your flight to Bangkok. On arrival at Suvarnabhumi Airport get transferred to your hotel for a stay of 2 nights.

Bangkok, the capital of Thailand, is one of Asia's most exciting cities. Located on the Chao Phraya River, Bangkok is the main commercial, political and tourist ub of the country. Go shopping on Sukhumvit, or visit the famous Wat Sai floating market or take a river taxi on the river. Bangkok is full of surprises!

Later in the afternoon, you will be taken on a city tour of Bangkok.

You tour includes a visit to the Temple of the Golden Buddha, home to the impressive 3m tall, 5 ½ tonne solid gold Buddha image.

Overnight at Amari Watergate or similar.



Day 2 - Day at leisure

After breakfast this morning, the rest of the day is at leisure.

Safari Word: Proceed on a full day visit to Safari World, Thailands most popular open zoo and show park. Safari World, spread over 200 acres, comprises Safari Park and Marine park and offers fun and entertainment for all ages. You can drive through a picturesque African wilderness, have an intimate encounter with dolphins or enjoy an exilhirating action stunt spectacular.

Visit the Floating Markets, Snake Park, The Palace.

Or simply indulge in some shopping.

Overnight at Amari Watergate or similar.





Day 3 - On the Chiang Mai

Today after breakfast get transferred to the airport for your flight to Chiang Mai. On arrival get transferred to the Hotel for a stay of 2 nights.

Chiang Mai is a city in mountainous northern Thailand that dates back to the 1200s. Its Old City area still retains vestiges of walls and moats from its history as a cultural and religious center. It's also home to hundreds of elaborate temples, including 14th-century Wat Phra Singh and 15th-century Wat Chedi Luang, adorned with carved serpents

Later in the afternoon, take a half day Doi Suthep tour.

Doi Suthep is the most famous of Chiang Mai's temples and its most prominent sitting at 1685 meters above the city. Nestled on a small sub peak on Doi Pui mountain the temple affords spectacular views across the city and beyond. Even for those who are not temple buffs the view is worth the trip alone. We will take you up the winding road towards the base of the temple, here you will have the choice of tackling the 306 steps to the temple or there is a funicular railway for those who are less steady on their feet. Following the temple visit it we will then proceed to visit a Hmong hill tribe settlement. Doi Suthep Temple is a 'must see' on any visit to Chiang Mai. For those who are interested we can arrange a visit to Phu Ping Palace which is situated between the Hmong village and Doi Suthep. Before transferring you to your hotel we will stop by a real Thai local market (either Warorot or Payom) where you can take in all the sights and sounds that a working local market offers.

Overnight at Dusit D2 Chiang Mai or similar.

Day 4 - Day at leisure

After breakfast this morning, the rest of the day is at leisure to take some optional tours.

Optional tour - Elephant Riding and Bamboo Rafting

Elephant lovers wouldn't want to miss out on this one. Thai elephants are playful and loveable. They are big. They are smart and gentle. And do you know that they are naturally born artists too? Get to know them and you'll see for yourself.

On this one-day tour, journey into the heart of Chiang Mai's verdant highland and learn the elephant's way of living, eating, playing, working and even painting. Witness a fascinating elephants' talent show, then ride on an elephant's back into the surrounding hilly landscape. A relaxing bamboo rafting experience along the rustic Mae Taeng River completes this memorable day.

Overnight at Dusit D2 Chiang Mai or similar.

Day 5 - Depart Chiang Mai

Today after breakfast, check out and morning is free at leisure to explore this historical town.

Later in the afternoon, get transferred to the airport for your flight back to India.
