Itinerary

Day 1 NAIROBI

Arrival of your flight at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. You will be met by our team outside the immigration hall. Transfer to the **Southern Sun Mayfair Hotel**, check in and relax.

Overnight at Southern **Sun Mayfair Hotel**

Meals : No meals

DAY 2 NAIROBI - LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

07h30: Breakfast at the hotel, safari briefing and depart to **Lake Nakuru national park**. An easy relaxing sightseeing drive via subsistence farming communities. Tea and coffee plantations will be seen along the

route. Have a brief stop over the rift valley escarpment. Drive on past the rift valley lakes Naivasha and Elementaita. Lake Nakuru national park hosts large flocks of flamingoes, pelicans and other bird species. It's a bird paradise and home to rhinos, warthogs, lions, zebras, giraffes and many more animal species. Arrive at the camp/lodge, check in, lunch and relaxation. In the afternoon, game drive in the park, dinner and overnight stay.

Overnight at **Sarova Lion Hill Game Lodge**

Meals : Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

DAY 3 –LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK -MASAI MARA

After breakfast, set off to the splendid Masai Mara National Reserve, which offers a stunning variety of animals. The reason is that this hilly region is both humid and fertile, and is crossed by the rivers Mara and Telek, which flow all year and are full of crocodiles and hippos. The banks of the rivers are covered in thick forest, which gradually makes way for bush and grassland. The abundance of water and excellent availability of food are the reasons why the Masai Mara, which in fact is a continuation of the Tanzanian Serengeti National Park, has the greatest population of wild animals in the whole of Africa. You will see huge herds of Wildebeest and Zebras. Predators such as Hyenas, Jackals, Leopards and Lions closely follow these herds. There is no place where more of these predators may be seen than in Masai Mara. Gigantic herds of over 200 buffaloes can also be observed. Plenty of food is available for elephants, giraffes, and the many species of antelopes and gazelles all of which can be observed in their natural habitat.

Arrival at your Camp and check-in.

After lunch, depart for an afternoon game drive in the park.

Overnight at **Mara Fig Tree**

Meals : Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

DAY 4 – MASAI MARA

Full day spent game-viewing in the reserve. With over 450 species of birds and abundant large mammal species. Explore the plains and rolling hills for a chance to spot the images of your dreams ranging from beautiful scenery to fascinating views of wildlife, in a natural habitat. Morning and afternoon game drives or a full day game drive with packed lunches would take you closer to nature. All meals and overnight at the lodge.

Overnight at **Mara Fig Tree**

Meals : Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

Day 5 – MASAI MARA - TRAVEL TO DIANI BEACH

Early Morning game drive followed by breakfast at the camp. Check-out.

Travel Options:

A : Direct flight from Masai Mara to Ukunda / Diani Beach : 2 hours departs at 14h00, arrival 16h00

B : Drive from Masai Mara to Nairobi (5h30) and then board a flight from Wilson Airport direct to Ukunda / Diani Beach – departs at 14h30, arrival 15h40.

C : Flight from Nairobi to Masai Mara to connect Nairobi Wilson to Ukunda

On arrival at Ukunda Airstrip, met by our team and transfer to your beach resort.
Check in, relax and enjoy the beach. Dinner and overnight stay.

Overnight stay at **Southern Palms Beach Resort**

Meals : Breakfast and Dinner

Day 6 – DIANI BEACH

2 days at leisure at your Diani beach resort with meals and accommodation.

There are many excursions to marine parks, traditional villages, Mombasa city and nearby game reserves proposed by our team.

We recommend the Kisite - Mpunguti marine reserve tour to sample the beauty of the coral reef gardens.

Overnight at **Southern Palms Beach Resort**

Day 7 – DIANI BEACH – MOMBASA AIRPORT - DEPART

After breakfast transfer to the Moi International Airport for your international flight.
