1.) Sri Swami Narayan Temple (Approx. Time 20 Min)

Made in marble, intricate carvings adorn the pillars and ceiling of the most expensive temple built in the state of Gujarat recently.

2.) Kutch Museum (Approx. Time 30 Min)

A visit to the Kutch Museum, to learn about the history of tribal and folk tradition of the district, will help you get to know about present-day people and their lives. Remember that visiting a museum is a great way to learn about history, but tribal are not merely part of history, they are a major part of Kutch's (and India's) population and cultural identity today. (Kutch museum remains closed on Wednesday) (Visit to Sri Swami Narayan Temple & Kutch Museums subject to its schedule timing)

3.) Bhujodi [Handicraft Village & Craft Park] (Approx. Time 40 Min)
