

Sultanate Highlights



Perched on the Arabian Gulf is the beautiful country – Oman, it is gradually becoming one of the choicest tourist destinations of the world.

Muscat is the capital of Oman and being centrally located it makes a tourist hub in Oman. Till date it keeps the integrity of its tradition well treasured. Sandwiched between the Brown-Dusty Mountains and blue seas, Muscat looks beautiful in its settlements. The seas continue to play an important role in the city life – for the fishing business, for tourists to take a plunge or even for diving in lagoons nearby.

Day 1 – Arrival

Upon arrival, meet & assist at the Muscat International airport, proceed to Ruwi Hotel. (Lunch & dinner optional)

Day 2 – Half Day Muscat city tour

After breakfast at the hotel, This tour begin at 9 am hrs visit to the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, an architectural monument, the client will take maximum 45 minutes to 01 hour to visit the mosque, at 1045 hrs the client will proceed to Royal Opera House for a photo stop only for 10 minutes. A stop at Muttrah, the main port area, leads to explore an ancient and colorful souk for 01 hour. At 1250 hrs the client will proceed to Bait Al Zubair museum, which showcases Omani heritage with a vast collection of antiques, traditional Omani weaponry, jewellery, costumes, domestic utensils and recreated urban and rural environments for maximum 30 minutes. Then drive through old Muscat, surrounded by steep mountains and flanked by the twin 16th century Jalali and Mirani forts, extends to Al Alam Palace of His Majesty Sultan Qaboos. Proceed back to Hotel. Overnight stay at in Ruwi hotel. (Lunch & dinner optional). (grand mosque visit not possible on Friday)

Day 3 – Dolphin Watching tour

After Breakfast at the hotel, proceed for Dolphin Watching tour. 8 – 10 am. Pick up from hotel 7.45 am

Say hello to the Dazzling Dolphins! This 2 hour cruise will take you around Oman’s enchanting coastline to give you a mesmerizing experience of the seldom missing dolphins at sea. Species like Spinner, Bottlenose or Indo-Pacific, are in easy sight at any time of the year. There definitely is no delight that matches up to watching the captivating energy of a school of dolphins bouncing and skirting around your boat.

Note: It’s usually very easy meeting the dolphins, but we cannot guarantee your luck!

Rest for the day at leisure to enjoy resort facilities. Overnight stay at in Ruwi hotel. (Lunch & dinner optional)

Day 4 – Muscat – Jabal Akhdar Tour.

Breakfast at the hotel. 9 am depart for Jabal Akhdar tour.

The tour begins at Nizwa, exploring its fort and traditional market. The journey continues to Wadi al Madeen, from where a 36-km drive through a scenic mountain road brings visitors to Al Jabal Al Akhdar (2000 metres above sea level), the green mountain of Hajjar mountain ranges, truly a unique attraction in the Arabian Peninsula. Al Jabal Al Akhdar is famed for its temperate cool climate and tropical fruit orchards. The villages overlook a spectacular landscape of awesome peaks, gorges and wadis. Return back to Muscat by evening.

Overnight in Ruwi hotel. (Lunch optional)

Day 5 – Departure

After breakfast, leisure time. Check out & proceed to airport for your flight back home
